

## Discussion Questions for the *Twilight* Saga by Stephenie Meyers

1. Why do you think the *Twilight* series is so popular?
2. What's your favorite thing about *Twilight*? Is it the characters? Plot? Setting? The supernatural/vampire element? Something else?
3. Which book in the series is your favorite? Least favorite? Why?
4. Who is your favorite character? Least favorite? Why?
5. The vampires of *Twilight* are different than the superstitions. What are some of the traditions about vampires from history and literature that you are aware of? How do the *Twilight* vampires differ? How are they the same?
6. What was your favorite scene in the book? What one sticks in your mind the most?
7. Do you think like either the books or the movies better than the other one? If you do, why?
8. What do you think of Carlisle's decision to 'save' people by making them vampires? Should he have let them die? After all, not every vampire can renounce blood, and a vampire can never have a 'normal' life or 'normal' relationships every again. If you were dying, would you want to be made into a vampire? Why or why not?
9. Edward reveals to Bella that he has spied on her at night, even been in her room. He has definitely violated her privacy and without her consent. What do you think of his actions? Especially considering that Edward doesn't know if he can resist biting Bella until *after* he starts his night-time visits? Would it be all right with you if someone you liked came in your room at night and spied on you?

11. What other books would you recommend to someone who enjoyed the *Twilight* series?
